Meeting

1. Welcome, Roll call
 - 24 participants on call
2. CGI Administrative
 - 45 registered members, 113 individuals on the main CGI distribution list
 - Stig Korsgaard reported that the growing importance of the CGI is illustrated by the continuing natural growth in membership. He extended a specific welcome to the Japanese banks.
 - From the current membership, 4 original members have not re-signed the updated Governance Rules covering IPR. Stig Korsgaard informed the plenary that he has actively pursued their signing, and would continue to do so. He recommended a time extension until end of August 2011, and suspension with notice for those original members who had not re-signed. Recommendation endorsed by the Plenary.
 - Stig Korsgaard introduced a draft document covering the proposed CGI approval and maintenance process and sought initial feedback. Positive reaction from Plenary, suggestion to adopt the ISO nomenclature of "normative" and "informative" to categorise CGI deliverables. Stig to update document and distribute for member review and comment, mid August 2011.
